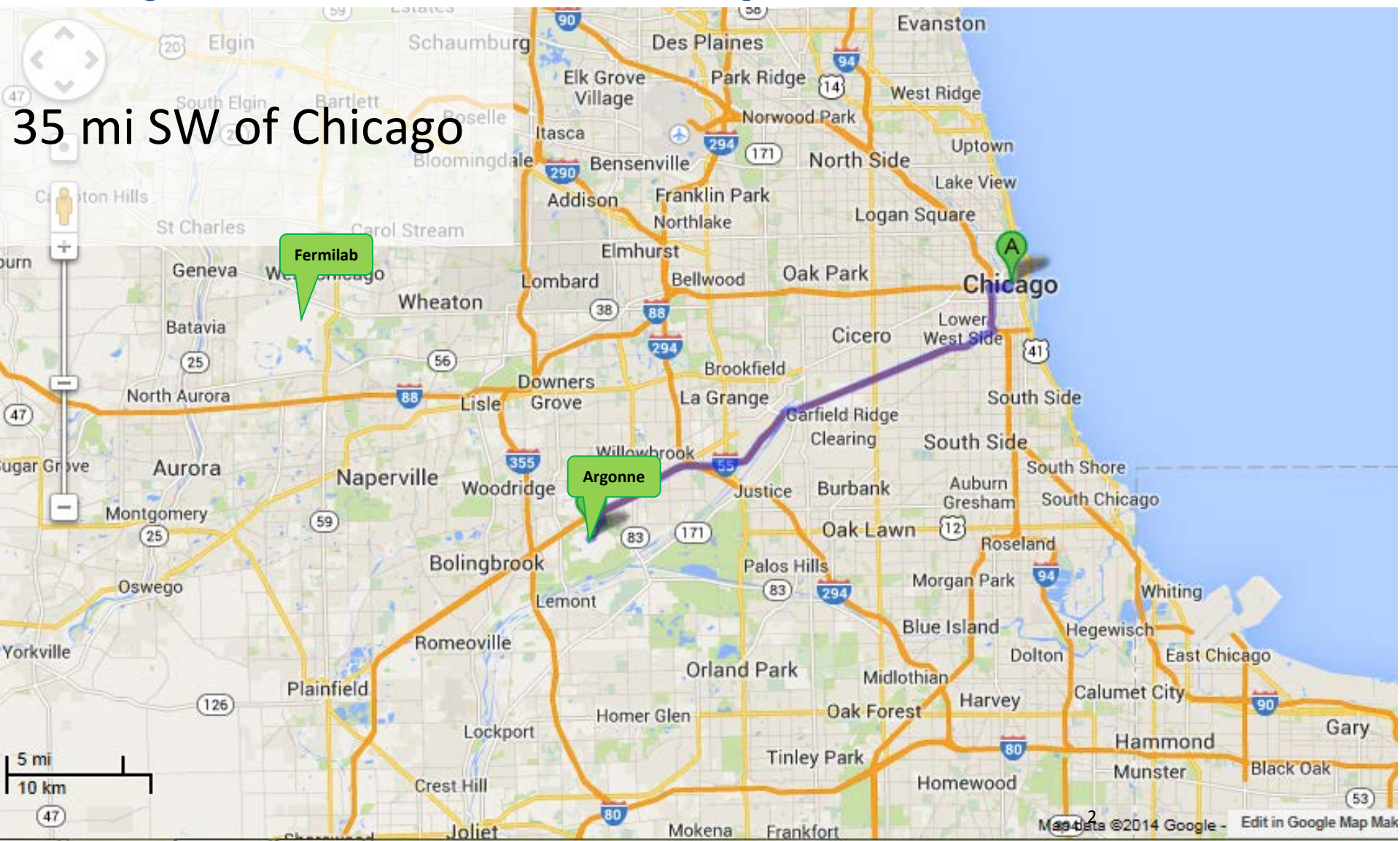

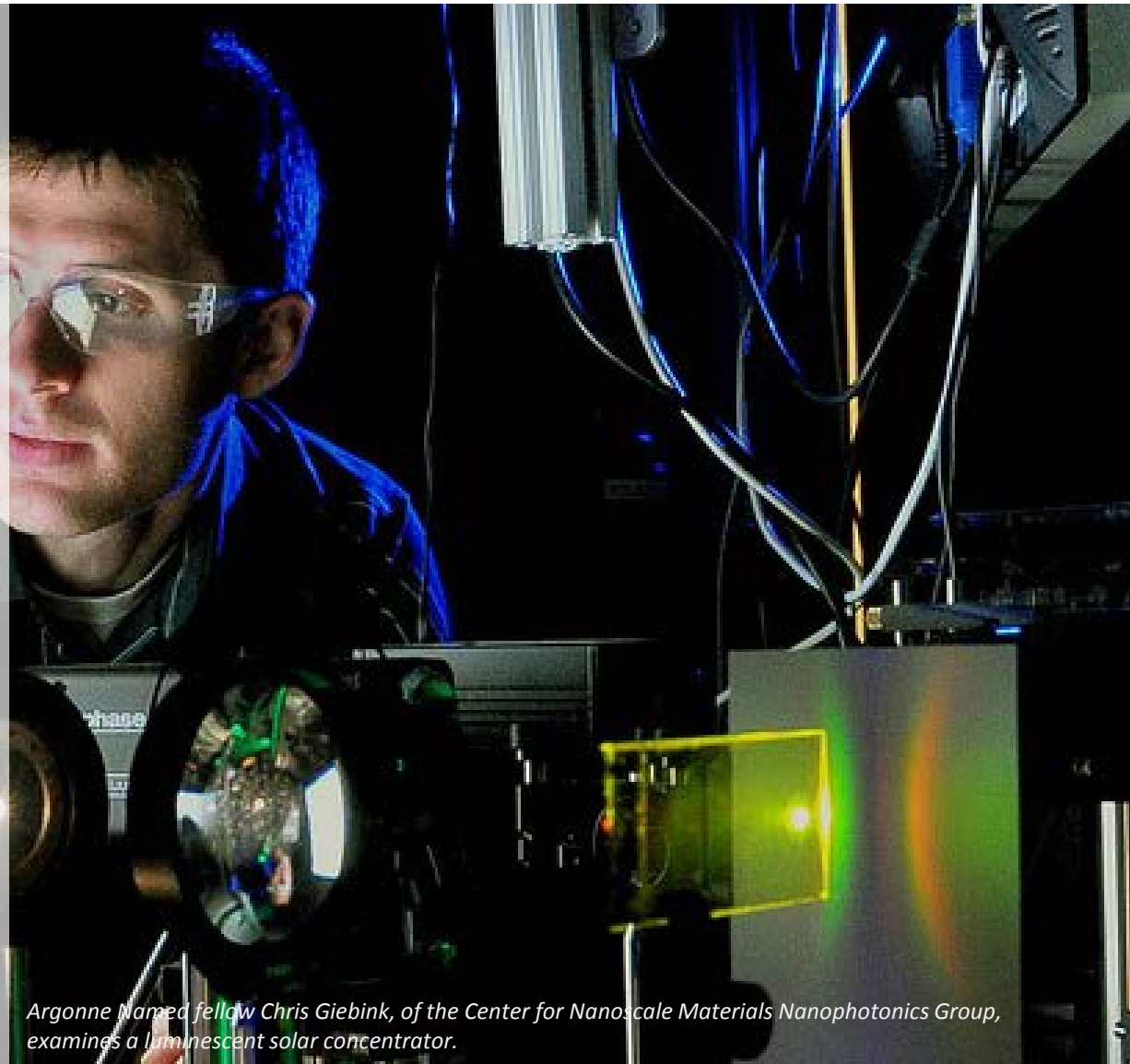

Argonne Named fellow Chris Giebink, of the Center for Nanoscale Materials Nanophotonics Group, examines a luminescent solar concentrator.

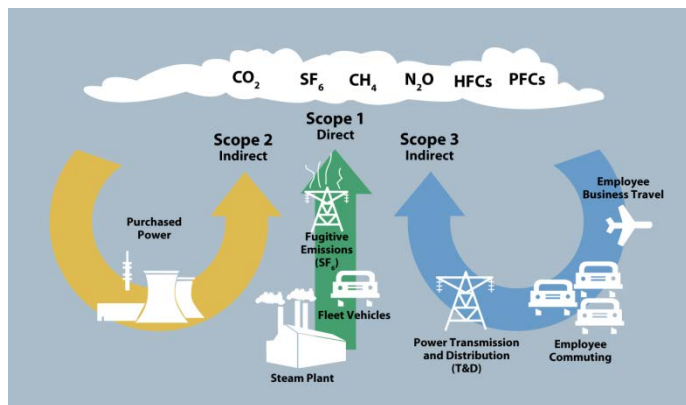
EV Charging at Argonne: Drivers & Challenges

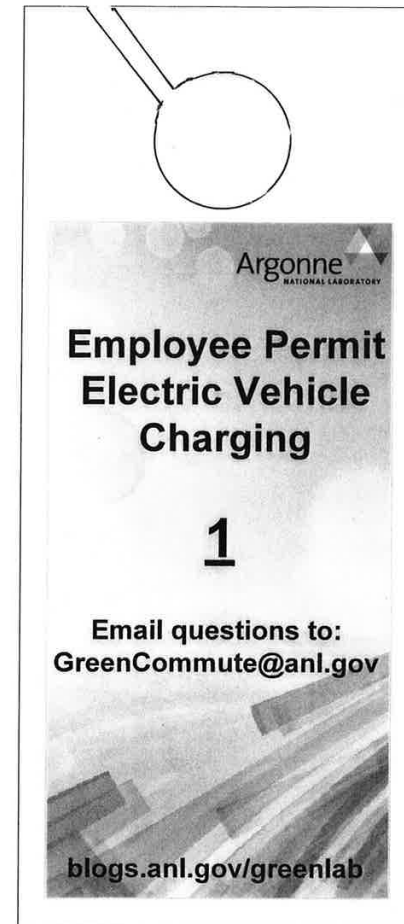
